

Technology Use Contract

In order to maintain our excellent computer/technology network at Balfour Collegiate it is necessary to communicate high expectations for their usage. We request the support of parents/guardians to assist us in maintaining responsible student use. Opportunities for all students to explore the world of information using computers, media retrieval, audio and video production are provided throughout the school year. These opportunities enhance the skills necessary for effective research, writing, communicating and presenting. We encourage flexible use of the technology; however we have established specific business rules to protect the interests of all. The following technology use agreement is a mechanism whereby the students and their families have been informed of the access we will provide and also outlines the consequences should any violations occur. The following rules are necessary to ensure that we can allocate our financial and human resources to provide exciting technical experiences. Violations of the following make it necessary for us to spend inordinate amounts of time securing, monitoring, repairing and re-programming. Violations to the above mentioned rules will result in suspension or complete removal of access to the technology depending on the severity or frequency of the infraction.
