Event 1: Cap and Gown Ceremony

Balfour Collegiate 2018 Graduation Cap and Gown Ceremony is our formal exercise to acknowledge the success of students. Grade 12 students who have achieved the graduation requirements as set by the Ministry of Education as of June 22, 2018, will be eligible to participate and to receive diplomas. There are two parts to this event: the Cap and Gown pick up and the Cap and Gown Ceremony. As well, you will also find Valedictorian information in this section.

Cap and Gown Pick up

Monday, June 25, 2018 @ 1:30 – 3:00 in room 109 – Balfour

As we must collect the graduation gowns immediately after the graduation ceremony, students will pick up their caps and gowns earlier, in order to take pictures, etc. There is no time after the ceremony at the Turvey Centre to take photos.

- Caps and gowns distributed Monday, June 25, 2018 from 1:30 to 3:00 in room 109 at Balfour Collegiate
- The graduating student or parent must sign for the cap, stole, and gown so please do not send others to pick them up. Advisory teachers will distribute the caps, gowns, and stoles.
- Students should write their name inside their cap in order to identify it after they toss them at the end of the ceremony.
- Students keep the caps as a memento
- The stole and gown must be returned to your Advisory teacher, upstairs in the lounge of the Turvey Centre immediately after the ceremony. All students must meet their Advisory teacher upstairs to return the gowns. At this time students will receive their progress report.

Cap and Gown Ceremony

Parent Information

- Ceremony located at The Turvey Centre: 100 Armour Rd., Highway 6 N, in Regina.
- Ceremony is in the ballroom.
- There is unlimited seating available for this ceremony and no parking or admission charge to attend.
- All friends and family of the graduates are welcome to attend, free of charge.
- Enter through the main doors of the building. Ushers will greet you and provide you with a program.
- You will be seated on the main floor of the ballroom. Seats will be reserved at the front of the room for grads, so please avoid sitting in any rows marked as reserved.
- The front row of seats behind the grads will be reserved for those wanting to take pictures during the ceremony. Please proceed to this row to take pictures at the appropriate times and then return to your seat so others may do the same.
- Please plan to arrive well enough in advance to park and be seated before 9:00 a.m. Doors will open for families and guests at 8:30 a.m.
- Please make sure your student is dressed appropriately for a formal ceremony. The graduation gown leaves the collar and lower legs exposed. Please wear dress pants and shoes, or skirts/dresses & shoes.

Student Information

- Ceremony located at The Turvey Centre: 100 Armour Rd., Highway 6 N, Regina, in the ballroom.
- Students need to arrive at the Turvey Centre **no later than 8:30**. The doors will be open by 8:00 a.m.
- Go up the stairs to the Lounge. There you need to find your Advisory teacher and line up with them.
- At 8:55 your Advisory teacher will escort you into the ballroom to your seat.
- Immediately after the ceremony, please make sure you return your gown and stole to your Advisory teacher, upstairs in the Lounge. There is no time for pictures. Please ensure you take these prior to the Cap & Gown event.
- Please make sure you are dressed appropriately for a formal ceremony. The graduation gown leaves the collar and lower legs exposed. Please wear dress pants and shoes, or skirts/dresses and shoes.

Valedictorian

- In May, Grade 12 students will nominate a student to give the Class of 2017 address. Students will be asked to consider the academic, extra-curricular, and leadership efforts that individual students have made to Balfour Collegiate before they make their choices for Valedictorian.
- Valedictorian voting is done through grade 12 English classes. If you do not have a grade 12 English class second semester, please see Miss Clark in room 141 by May 2.
- The Valedictorian Speech is delivered at the Cap and Gown Ceremony.

Event 2: Grad Celebration

All students currently enrolled in Grade 12 classes at Balfour Collegiate are eligible to purchase tickets and attend the graduation celebration. There are a number of important pieces of information here, so please read carefully and review important timelines. **Please note that all school fees must be paid before you can purchase tickets.**

Graduation Celebration Ticket Purchase

Tuesday, May 1 to Thursday, May 31, 2018

- Tickets for the graduation celebration will be on sale from Tuesday, May 1st to Thursday, May 31st, 2018.
- Tickets will only be available during this time period. If you do not meet this deadline you will not be able to secure a ticket.
- **All school fees must be paid prior to purchasing grad tickets. Please contact Carla Timmons in the main office if you have any questions.**
- **You may purchase your tickets in person with cash. Bring your order form and cash to the main office between 8:00 and 3:45, between May 1st and May 31st, 2018.**
- **You may buy your tickets online with credit. You may do this from home between May 1st and May 31st, 2018. The link to the website is: <https://rbe.schoolcashionline.com>**
- **Graduates must purchase a ticket for themselves as well as one for each family member or guest.** This includes children and babies as fire regulations state that every person must be included in

our count.

- **Each graduate must purchase a ticket for \$30.** This secures your participation in the graduation celebration and the remainder of the evening. **If the graduate is bringing an escort who will attend the grads-only portion of the evening, a \$30 ticket must also be purchased for the escort.**
- **Other family members or guests must purchase a ticket for \$10** for the Grand March and speeches. These tickets do not include entry into the rest of the evening.
- **Graduates and their escorts can also purchase food in advance. Options and their prices are detailed on the ticket form (in print or online). Food will not be available for purchase the night of the event.**
- Rush seating is in effect. This means that upon arrival at the Turvey Centre, you will choose your seats on a first come first serve basis.
- Tickets must be produced for entry into the Ballroom at the Turvey Centre.

Graduation Celebration

Tuesday, June 26, 2018 – Turvey Centre

- The celebration will be held in Ballroom and Lounge of the Turvey Centre, Regina, on Tuesday, June 26th, 2018.
- The celebration will include a Grand March and student/parent/teacher speeches for all those in attendance.
- Following the formal program, students and their guests will stay for the remainder of the evening which will include a variety of activities (like a formal dance, other activities).
- **The timeline for the event is as follows:**
 - 5:15 – Doors Open – seating for families in Ballroom
 - 5:40 – Students line up in lobby for Grand March with their Advisory teacher
 - 6:00 – Grand March
 - 6:30 – Speeches
 - 8:00 – Graduates Group Photo in Ballroom
 - 8:30 – Graduates and escorts move upstairs for Celebration
 - 8:30-ish – Food is served for those who have bought it in advance
 - 11:30 – Event is complete

Graduation Celebration speeches

- There are a number of speeches delivered during the program at the graduation celebration. Grade 12 students are encouraged to apply for one of the following speaking parts. Information and applications will be available through second semester English classes. If you do not have an English class second semester, please see Miss Clark before May 1.
 - Master(s) of ceremony
 - Toast to the Ladies
 - Toast to the Gentlemen
 - Toast to the Teachers
 - Toast to the Parents
- Members of the Student Graduation Committee will nominate parents and teachers to deliver the Toast to the Students and the Speech to the Graduates.

Balfour Graduation Celebration Rules of Conduct

1. Your attendance at and participation in the Graduation Celebration event will denote complete agreement and willingness to comply with the rules of conduct and behavior expectations.
2. Drugs and alcohol are not permitted at any time. Any use of drugs or alcohol before or during the Graduation Celebration event will automatically end your evening of farewell. Guardians will be called and instructed to pick up their graduate (and guest).
3. All graduates and their guests will require their Graduation Celebration ticket to enter.
4. No backpacks or large handbags. Small purses will be allowed and will be subjected to search.
5. Once you have entered the Graduation Celebration space, if you leave it you will not be permitted to re-enter.
6. Grads are responsible for the conduct of their escort. Both individuals will be required to leave should any of the rules be broken by either person.
7. Chaperones will be treated with respect and courtesy.

Balfour Collegiate and its affiliates are not responsible for any losses/injuries incurred as a result of this event.

Any graduate and/or escort who is in violation of the rules and expectations will be asked to leave in the accompaniment of their guardian. Students involved in illegal behavior will be handed over to the Regina City police.
